

SUBMITTAL 5 – Response to Coastal Staff Questions of April 30th, 2007**

Dear Mr. Delaplaine,

At our meeting with you on April 30th, 2007, a number of follow-up and clarification questions were articulated by you and your staff colleagues. As we have done in the past, we took careful note of your questions and immediately began to compile responses.

We have previously sent to you four submittals: Submittal 1, sent last year, included the Final EIR and Technical Reports for the project. Submittal 2, sent in February of this year, included responses to those questions you and your staff posed in our December 5th, 2006 meeting. Submittal 3, sent in March of this year, included our Consistency Certification, a Roadway Description and Related Features Report, the project Jurisdictional Delineation, 1602, and 401 permit applications, and a focused summary of environmental impacts within the Coastal Zone. Submittal 4 was presented to you in person at our April 30th meeting, and included information you requested pertaining to the campground, biological issues, greenhouse gas emissions, and water quality.

Accompanying this letter are the documents intended to comprise Submittal 5. These include a list of anticipated agency actions, a memo describing the existing traffic conditions south of the Orange County/San Diego County border, a breakdown of our mitigation areas, an updated set of jurisdictional delineation maps, the I-5 cross sections at the location of proposed soundwalls, updated sediment transport letters and the response to the PWA Report. In addition, we have attached a matrix of the questions from April 30th that we are responding to.
