At our very productive meeting with you and several of your staff colleagues on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2006, a number of questions were articulated by Commission staff. We took careful note of your questions and immediately began to compile responses.

We previously sent you the Final EIR and Technical Reports as our first submittal. This is the second submittal and includes information already in the record and readily available to answer many of your initial questions from our December 5<sup>th</sup> meeting. We chose to provide the information in phases to get information to you as soon as possible and to lessen the burden of review on your part. We hope to keep this round of submittals to three.

Accompanying this letter are the documents intended to comprise the Submittal 2 responses to your December 5<sup>th</sup> questions. In addition, we have attached a matrix of the questions from December 5<sup>th</sup> that we are responding to.

We are continuing to work to assemble the plans and documents that respond directly to your remaining questions regarding: the Biological Opinion issues by USFWS; TCA's park enhancement proposal; water quality information; State Park enforcement issues; detailed bridge and bridge approach design and construction impacts; additional information on sediment supply and handling of slope vs. roadway runoff; preparation of the RMP; and evaluation of global warming and noise issues. We will provide them to you as soon as possible.
