This letter serves to inform you that the Section 106 review of the Broadwater LNG terminal and its associated pipeline has been concluded insofar as potential archaeological effects are concerned. It is the opinion of the State Historic Preservation Office that the construction of these facilities will have no effect on historic or cultural resources. Our file, however, remains open regarding the potential effects of support terminal construction in Long Island.
