

I am writing to express my concern about the Broadwater proposal to place a Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) terminal in the middle of the Long Island Sound. The Long Island Sound does not need a costly and risky LNG barge. The tranquil Long Island Sound would be forever ruined by private armed security forces surrounding the barge. Broadwater is too costly, risky, and is not needed in the Sound. This facility limits public access and sets a dangerous precedent of industrializing the Sound.
