Dear Secretary Evans,

I am writing as a friend and neighbor of Teatown Lake Reservation, a 759-acre nature preserve and education center located in the Croton Watershed and in the path of the proposed Millennium Pipeline, to express my belief that you should not overturn a correct and properly made decision by New York State regarding the Millennium Gas Pipeline crossing of the Hudson River as proposed.

On May 9, 2002, the New York Department of State issued its determination:

The Department of State's decision found that the proposal was inconsistent with the provisions of the federal Coastal Zone Management Act and violated its policies in several ways by:

- *Adversely affecting the State-designated Haverstraw Bay Significant Coastal Fish and Wildlife Habitat.*
- *Not adequately addressing concerns regarding the drinking water supply for New York City and some Westchester Communities.*
- *Being inconsistent with the Village of Croton-on-Hudson's Local Waterfront Revitalization Program.*

Teatown's preserve would be severely impacted by this pipeline route, as would the watershed in which it plays a major role. Teatown's wetlands, lake and streams are currently providing vital protection to the Croton Reservoir by filtering pollution through wetland plants and preventing flooding through the many systems available in the natural environment. Construction of the Millennium Pipeline through Teatown would destroy these natural systems so important for the protection of public drinking water, not to mention the impact it would have on Teatown's operation as a regional environment education center serving over 40,000 citizens each year.

I respectfully request a decision that upholds New York's right to protect its coastline, environment, and citizens.
