In accordance with your letter dated August 11, 2005, the Marine Safety Center has conducted a preliminary review of relevant portions of Broadwater Energy's application to install an offshore liquefied natural gas receiving terminal and floating storage and regasification unit (FSRU) in Long Island Sound.
