As grounds for this Petition to Intervene, Attorney General Blumenthal respectfully submits:

1. Petitioner is a duly elected constitutional officer of the State of Connecticut, charged by law with the duty to represent the State on all legal matters affecting the State.
2. The security zones associated with the proposed project will lie, in part, within the territorial limits of the State of Connecticut. The project itself will be built within 1.2 miles of Connecticut's lands and waters, and it will affect important marine and other natural resources within the State which are held in public trust for the citizens of the State. The proposal will also raise important legal issues concerning the rights of the State of Connecticut.
3. As the officer of the State of Connecticut responsible for representing the State in all legal matters, Petitioner is the official most responsible for protecting the State's legal rights associated with this project.

4. The public interest requires that the Attorney General be permitted to intervene on behalf of the State of Connecticut and its people regarding a proposal which will have major impacts upon them.
5. No disruption of these proceedings will result from granting the Attorney General party status.
6. The Attorney General's interest will not be adequately represented by any other party to these proceedings.
7. Existing parties will not be unfairly prejudiced by the Attorney General's becoming a party to these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Commission grant the petition.
