

As grounds for this Petition to Intervene, Chairman Fasano and Vice-Chairperson Stillman respectfully submit:

1. The petitioners are duly elected officials of the State of Connecticut and are appointed as chairpersons of a task force specifically established by order of Her Excellency M. Jodi Rell, Governor of the State of Connecticut, to represent the State in all proceedings before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, as well as other Federal and State agencies considering the Broadwater application.
2. The Task Force has taken great pains to investigate and understand the many aspects of the proposed Broadwater project, as they may effect the State of Connecticut and its citizens, and by virtue of its membership comprised of elected and appointed officials as well as members of the general public, is in position to provide the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission with the most credible comment on the matter.
3. While the Broadwater project is proposed to be in the territorial waters of New York State, the public interest of the State of Connecticut and its citizens is unquestionable in this matter, as Long Island Sound, a Federally recognized "estuary of national significance" is a unified body of water without delineable environmental boundaries.
4. No disruption of these proceedings will result from granting this Task Force party status.
5. The interests of the Task Force will not fully be represented by any other party to these proceedings.
6. Existing parties will not be unfairly prejudiced by the Task Force becoming a party to these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioners respectfully request that the Commission grant the petition.
