**MOTION OF
WEAVER’S COVE ENERGY, LLC
FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE**

Pursuant to Rules 211 and 214(d) and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.211 and 214(d), Weaver’s Cove Energy, LLC (“Weaver’s Cove”), respectfully submits this motion for leave to intervene in the captioned proceedings. In support of it’s motion, Weaver’s Cove states as follows:

I: Statement of Issues

Whether, pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R § 385.214, Weaver’s Cove should be granted intervention?

II. Introduction

Weaver’s Cove is a limited liability company organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Delaware, with its principal place of business located in Fall River, Massachusetts. Weaver’s Cove is proposing to develop a liquefied natural gas (“LNG”) receiving and storage terminal to be located at a site on the eastern bank of the Taunton River approximately one mile north of the City of Fall River in southeastern Massachusetts.

IV: Description of Proceedings

On January 30, 2006 Broadwater Energy, LLC filed an application under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act and Part 153 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations seeking authorization to site, construct and operate an offshore liquefied natural gas receiving terminal and associated facilities in Long Island Sound, approximately nine miles from the shore of Long Island in New York State waters, as a place of entry for the importation of LNG. Broadwater Energy, LLC requested that the Commission issue a final order granting all necessary authorizations by March 31, 2008.

V: Request to Intervene

As the project sponsor of a proposed new LNG facility and new lateral pipeline facilities in New England, Weaver's Cove has interests in the outcome of this proceeding that cannot be adequately represented by any other party. Further, Weaver's Cove respectfully submits that its interest may be affected by the outcome of this proceeding, within the meaning of section 385.214(b)(2) of the Commission's regulations.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Weaver's Cove moves to intervene in the captioned proceedings, with full rights as a party.
