**MOTION OF
DOMINION COVE POINT, LNG, LP
FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE**

Pursuant to Rules 211 and 214(d) and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission), 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.211 and 214(d), Dominion Cove Point LNG, LP (Cove Point) respectfully submits this motion for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceedings. In support of its motion, Cove Point states as follows:

I. Description of Cove Point

Cove Point is a limited partnership organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware. Cove Point’s headquarters and principal place of business are 120 Tredegar Street, Richmond, VA 23219.

Cove Point owns and operates a liquefied natural gas (“LNG”) terminal in Calvert County, Maryland and pipeline facilities that extend approximately 87 miles from the terminal to interconnections with Columbia Gas Transportation, Dominion Transmission, Inc., and Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation. Cove Point receives supplies of imported LNG at the terminal, temporarily stores the LNG in its liquid state, and delivers volumes of regasified

LNG on behalf of shippers to markets in the Mid-Atlantic regions, and beyond, through its connections with the interstate pipeline network. 1/

III. Description of Proceedings

On January 30, 2006, Broadwater Energy LLC (Broadwater) filed an application seeking authorization to site, construct and operate an offshore liquefied natural gas (LNG) receiving terminal and associated facilities in Long Island Sound. Also on January 30, 2006 Broadwater Pipeline LLC (Broadwater Pipeline), filed an application requesting a certificate authorizing them to construct own, operate and maintain a subsea lateral and related facilities. Broadwater Energy and Broadwater Pipelines requested in the proceeding that the commission issue a final order granting all necessary authorizations for the Broadwater LNG Project by March 31, 2008.

IV. Conclusion

The Cove Point terminal is only one of four LNG import facilities in the Continental U.S. As a potential competitor of Broadwater and Broadwater Pipeline, Cove Point has a substantial

interest in these proceedings that no other party can adequately address, and its intervention and participation in these proceedings will serve the public interest.
