AFFIDAVIT OF HELENE FARREY


HELENE FARREY, being duly sworn, deposes and says:




AFFIDAVIT OF CHARLES A. KANE

Charles A. Kane, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I reside at 68 Truesdale Drive, Croton-on-Hudson, New York. I have been a resident of the Village of Croton-on-Hudson since 1959, and have lived within five miles of the Croton River for my entire life.
2. I have worked as a licensed commercial fisherman on the Hudson River and I am an avid sport fisherman. I have been fishing the Croton River since 1956.
3. During the past year, I have caught or observed a number of species of fish on the Croton River. Among these species is the ocean run Brown Trout, which enter the Croton River estuary in the fall to spawn. The ocean run Brown Trout is easily distinguished from locally-stocked Brown Trout by the small spots on their sides, a silvery appearance, and a lack of dark brown color on top.
4. In addition to the ocean run Brown Trout, during the past year I have caught or observed the following fish species in the Croton River: native Brook Trout, Striped Bass, American Shad, Hickory Shad, and a number of Alewife species, including Blueback Herring and Atlantic Herring.
